

Computable law for all.

The rules that decide who gets food assistance, health coverage, and tax credits live in closed code that no one outside the vendor can check. **The Axiom Foundation** publishes those rules in the open — cited, computable, and verified.

WHAT WE DO

- 1 Encode — we turn the law into software.** An encoder pipeline reads a statute and drafts its encoding in RuleSpec. Every value cites its authority, every clause carries its effective dates, and each decision is recorded alongside the source text.
- 2 Verify — a deterministic gauntlet decides what ships.** Every draft must compile and pass its test suite to merge, and oracles cross-check results against external engines — so the model that wrote the rules never grades its own work.
- 3 Publish — we put the whole chain in public.** The Axiom App holds the source document, the encoding, the validation record, and the computation graph in one place, openly licensed — so a claim about what a rule computes is something you can check.

Encodings are published under CC BY 4.0 and the code under Apache 2.0 — free to use, modify, and redistribute, with attribution.

WHAT WE ENABLE

Government	Stop paying to re-implement the same rules — one cited, dated, verified encoding that delivery systems, auditors, and legislators all work from.
Frontier AI labs	Make AI truthful about the law — executable, cited code a model can call instead of guess, and an evaluation set for scoring what it answers unassisted.
Research	A citable, executable corpus of law — effective-dated encodings cross-checked against external engines, and a computation graph that is analyzable data.
Builders	Ground truth for the rules your product touches — the hardest, least differentiated layer of your stack, maintained in the open instead of by you.
